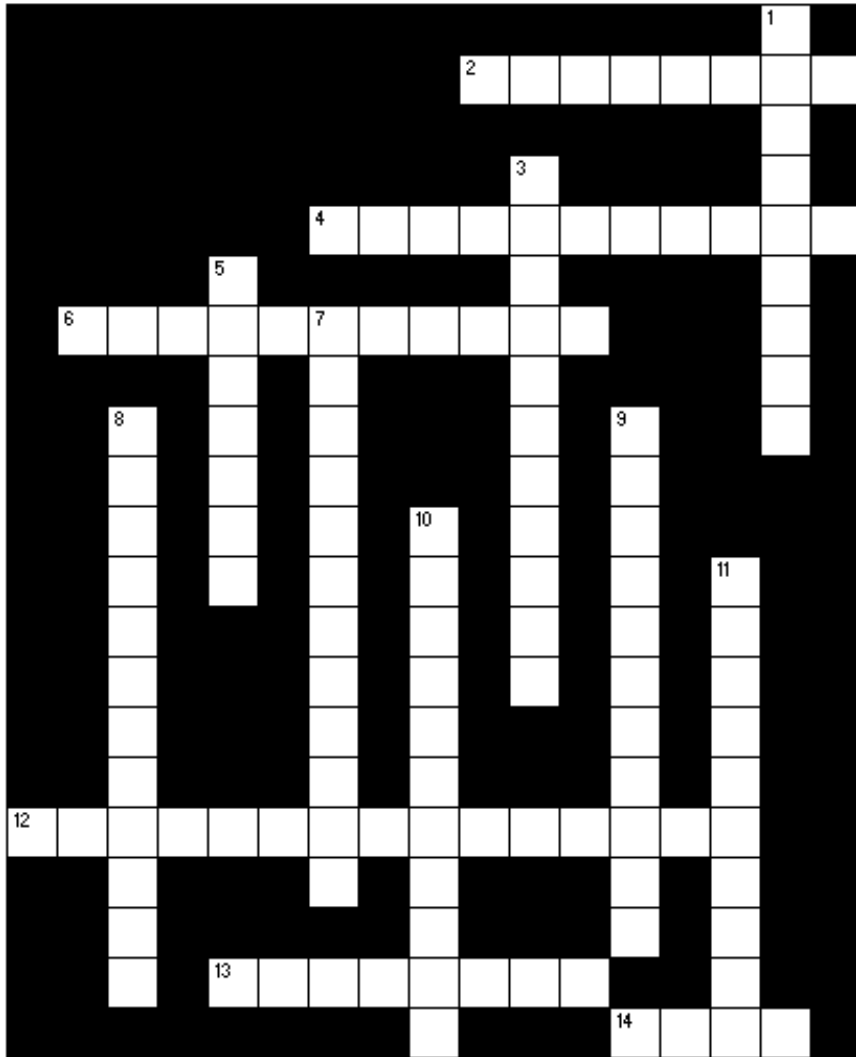


## Crossword clues based upon zone 1 & 2 stations on the London Underground



### DOWN

- 1 This station in the East End of London will bring you to the Crown Jewels (5, 4)
- 3 A famous fictional private detective shared lodgings on a street of the same name with his loyal sidekick and landlady (5, 6)
- 5 Which cathedral, designed by Christopher Wren, has the nearby station in the City of London named after it (2, 5)
- 7 What station in central London is associated with the former fruit-and-vegetable market in the central square of the same name, now a popular shopping and tourist site (6, 6)
- 8 You would get out at this station if you wanted to do a bit of shopping on King's Road (6, 6)
- 9 Named after the country that has the maple leaf as its symbol, along with what flows under a bridge (6, 5)
- 10 This station is nearest the famous recording studios used by the Beatles, where the cover of their album of the same name features the band using the nearby zebra crossing (2, 5, 4)
- 11 This station in North London is conveniently located for its famous markets by the canal which were devastated by fires twice in the past few years (6, 4)

- 4 This station, in an affluent part of London, could be described as a Dutch recreational ground (7, 4)
- 6 This district in the East End was notorious for Jack the Ripper in the late 1880's (11)

- 13 This station, where three London Underground lines converge, shares its name with a famous female British monarch (8)
- 14 Which station in the City of London is named for the institution known as the 'Old Lady of Threadneedle Street' (4)
